GUIDLINES

Artists can submit up to **TWO** Wearable Art Show pieces. Remember, each piece can have multiple models, and artists can model their own creations.

A model can appear in no more than **TWO** Wearable Art Show pieces.

Creations may, or may not, be for sale. KFSK receives 25% donation of all sales. **Commercial entries will not be accepted.**

DRESS REHEARSAL ON THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 20TH, IS MANDATORY.

Models must wear completed pieces at the dress rehearsal.

If multiple artists choose the same music, all artists will be notified. The first artist who turned in the application will have first priority in using the song.

Applicants must submit a music CD or file, <u>AND</u> emailed, or typed, narrative to be read by the MC while the model is on the stage. Applicants may burn their background music onto a disc or submit a music CD noting song number and name.

If you want specific information included in the emcee's introduction of your piece, please note it on your application under "Description."

KFSK reserves the right to exclude work that is inappropriate for this exhibit. Please use the CHECKLIST to make sure that you have a complete application.
